Cord & Cord Grip Installation

1. Remove cover from top of fixture (Figure 1). Save hardware and gasket.
2. Place sealing ring onto cord grip with wider rubber ring towards fixture.
3. Insert cord grip with sealing ring through hole in fixture (Figure 2).
4. Secure cord grip to fixture using conduit nut provided. Torque to 30-40 inch-pounds.
5. Loosen cap on cord grip, thread cord (not provided) through cord grip until minimum of 1.00 inch of cord jacket is visible inside driver housing.
6. Tighten cap on cord grip around cord until hand-tight plus ¼ turn.
7. Refer to standard installation instructions for wiring.

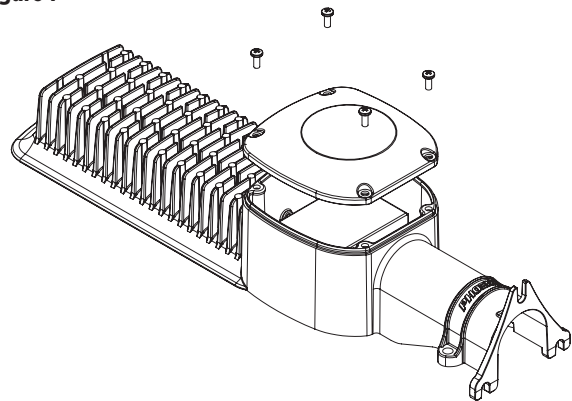
