Consent

By using the Site, you consent to this Policy. If you do not agree with this Policy, we ask that you refrain from use of the Site. Collection of Information

We collect personally identifiable information in connection with the Site. The types of personal information collected may include your name, user name, company name, address, email address, phone number, IP address, use and browser information as examples. We may also collect non-personal and anonymous information to be used in an aggregate fashion. This Policy applies solely to the information that we collect from our Site.

Cookies; Beacons

From time to time, we may also use “cookies”, “web beacons” or similar technology for the convenience of our users and to enhance your experience using the Site. A cookie is a small text file that is recorded either temporarily or persistently on your hard drive by a web page server and is not used to deliver viruses or other harmful programs to your computer. Rather, cookies enable us to recognize a user without requiring the user to repeatedly log in when using the Site. Web beacons are graphics designed to collect web log information such as pages viewed or messages opened. By relying on cookies, web beacons and similar technology, we may be able to deliver a more efficient service that is more personalized for each user. Additionally, these technologies may allow us to monitor traffic patterns, Site usage and session information to make the Site more useful.

Use of Information

We use information that we collect to assist us in improving and managing our operations. Examples of such use include without limit:

- Record keeping and other business operations.
- Sending promotional messages, special offers or other information that we think you may find helpful.
- From time to time, contacting you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, fax or mail. We may use the information to customize the Site according to your interests.

Disclosure of Information

We may also disclose your personal information to third parties when we believe, in good faith and at our sole discretion, that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to (a) enforce or apply the terms and conditions of the Site; (b) comply with legal or regulatory requirements; (c) protect the rights, property or safety of us, our users or other third parties; or (d) prevent a crime or protect national security. We may also disclose aggregate anonymous information to our clients, business partners, merchants, advertisers, investors, potential buyers and other third parties if we deem such disclosure, at our discretion, to have sound business reasons or justification.

Children

We do not knowingly or specifically collect personal information from users under 13 years of age. We do not authorize users under 13 years of age to use the Site.

Policy Changes

In particular, we may modify this Policy to reflect changes in the way we collect, use or disclose information, or to reflect changes in privacy laws, regulations and/or industry standards.
